I'm submitting this article to inform shipmates of a service that I used and benefited from.

It's not meant to be an endorsement, just informative and not binding by anyone to use it.

Several years ago, I joined USAA Insurance to take advantage of a lower Medicare Plan and prescription. Three years ago we were looking to sell our winter vacation home. At the time, USAA had a program for members only where USAA would find a realtor to sell your house. At first I wasn't interested as we wanted to Sell By Owner. USAA contacted me about a year later stating this program was going away but I could still take advantage of the program. Besides the benefit of USAA finding a reliable realtor, I, as the seller, would reap a small 'referral' fee upon selling it. Less than 1/2 percent depending on the final sale price.

Long story short, we sold the house in Sept. And I did get my 'referral fee', not from USAA but from **Realogy Real Estate Assistance Program**. They now manage this program for any service person, no need to be a member of USAA. The person who I dealt with was Courtney Frank Boothroyd, Real Estate Advocate II, Realogy Real Estate Assistance, Office: 1-800-528-8439. I believe they are located in CT?

This is what Courtney said about the program:

Thank you very much for your email. The Realogy Military Rewards program is offered to all Active Military, Veterans and Family of Military! If you would like to provide them with my contact information, you are welcome to give them my email address and I can set up a time with them to go over the program benefits! They can also call (888) 509-4368 and any Military Rewards Advocate would be able to assist them.

If you are not familiar with USAA, they offer a variety of services and insurance to all military personnel and their families. Only the person who served in the military can join and they in turn can have any family member join under them as well. Once you are deceased, family members who did not join cannot become members. AND there is NO cost or obligation once you join to purchase any products. Your children can take advantage of Medicare plans when they reach that time!

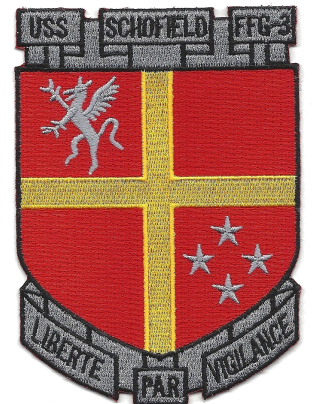
